

Transilvania Pitch Stop 2021 - Call for projects

Transilvania International Film Festival (July 23^d – August 1^{st} 2021) invites filmmakers to submit their projects to the newest edition of **Transilvania Pitch Stop** (TPS). The industry event will take place between July $29^{th} - 31^{st}$ 2021 in Cluj-Napoca, Romania.

The TPS co-production platform is open to feature-length fiction film projects of 1st and 2nd time directors coming from Romania, Hungary, Bulgaria, Serbia, Ukraine, Russia, Moldova, Greece, Turkey and Georgia.

TPS co-production platform presents a selection of up to 10 projects currently in development and financing to international film professionals (producers, distributors, sales agents, representatives from films funds etc.) facilitating their international visibility and establishing the right connections to ensure financing for their projects.

The projects can be in different stages of development. To be eligible, they must have at least 20% of the budget secured. It is preferable for projects to be designed from the outset as a European co-production, both artistically and financially, but it is not mandatory.

Deadline: June 3rd, 2021.

Participants will be informed of the selection results no later than June 15th, 2021. The list of awards will be announced soon.

Since its launch in 2014, over 70 projects have been developed within the frame of the TPS, among them *Apples* by Christos Nikou (Orizzonti Opening Film in Venice, Greek Entry for the Oscars), *The Man Who Surprised Everyone*, by Natasha Merkulova & Aleksey Chupov (awarded in the Orrizonti section), *Monsters*. by Marius Olteanu (Berlinale Forum), and the upcoming *La Civil*, by Teodora Ana Mihai.
